HEARD BY THE HERD

Heard by the Herd is the community engagement strand of Cows about Cambridge that has been funded by Arts Council England. Three experienced artists from Cambridge: Hilary Cox Condon, Penny Sobr and Beverley Carpenter, worked with participants from 3 under-represented community groups to explore the themes of identity and inclusion.

Members of the LGBTQ+ community, a group of young people from Abbey Teens and a collective of older women at risk of isolation took part in a series of workshops. They learnt new creative skills and, lead by the artists, the outputs and ideas from the sessions were stitched together to create an immersive and interactive installation.

The Heard by the Herd installation, which can be found in a vacant retail unit in The Grafton, forms part of the Cows about Cambridge art trail and will enable groups that have to work harder to get their voices heard to be involved in the largest public art event to take place in the city.
